Rules and Regulations

- ENTRIES:** PA HBF Futurity Yearling & Weanling entry fee is \$50.00 per class, all other classes are \$25.00. All entries are subject to an office fee of \$15.00 and a grounds fee of \$10.00. If a horse or pony is entered in more than one class the office and grounds fees are waived for the second class. **Pre-Entries must be postmarked by Saturday October 10, 2015. NO EXCEPTIONS.** All other entries accepted with a late fee of \$35.00 each. - COGGINS:** A negative coggins dated within the year 2015 is required for each entry.
- There will be a \$50.00 fee** for all returned checks and Futurity winnings will be held until all fees are paid.
- In the event that** an entry must be scratched, exhibitors may substitute another entry or may receive a \$20.00 refund for yearling & weanling horse/pony classes. Scratches must have a written and signed veterinary excuse. Refunds will **NOT** be given in the Amateur Adult/Jr. Handler, Mare Suitable to Produce, PA Bred, Young Hunter Horse/Pony, Get of sire, Produce of Dam & Breeders Group classes.
- The PA Hunter Breeder's Futurity, Magic Hill Farm, Marcus Sadler and Emily Anne Belin, and their principals, officers, agents and employees, WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE for any damage, injury or loss to any person, animal, property or exhibitors and spectators. It shall be a condition of entrance to the grounds that this is agreed.**
- All dogs** must be kept on a leash at all times.
- The Futurity** will be held rain or shine.
- The judge's** decision is final.
- THE YEARLING & WEANLING FUTURITY** is open to any horse or pony foaled in 2014 or 2015.
- Yearling & Weanling Futurity handlers** MAY show multiple entries in any of the classes.
- Weanlings** will be judged individually on conformation and movement. Weanlings and mares will be asked to walk only.
- AMATEUR/JR. HANDLER** is open to adults who are **NOT** professionals & Juniors who have not reached their 14th birthday as of December 1, 2014. Horses/ponies shown on the line by an amateur or junior will be judged on presentation of the animal, neatness and appearance of the handler, and overall condition of the animal. Conformation will not be a determining factor. This class is intended for the sole purpose of stimulating participation of the amateur and junior in the breeding division and does not limit that person to these classes.
- GET OF SIRE** is open to horses/ponies in a group of two or three animals, any age or sex, that are the offspring from the same stallion. Judged on conformation, type, way of moving and soundness. Combined ownership permitted but not necessary. Horses & ponies in any combination.
- PRODUCE OF DAM** is open to horses/ponies in a group of two or three animals, any age or sex, that are the produce from the same mare. Judged on conformation, type, way of moving and soundness. Combined ownership permitted but not necessary. Horses & ponies in any combination.
- BREEDER'S GROUP** is open to horses/ponies in a group of two or three animals, any age or sex, that were bred by the same breeder/farm. Judged on conformation, type, way of moving and soundness. Combined ownership permitted but not necessary. Horses and ponies in any combination.

Rules and Regulations

16. **YOUNG HUNTER HORSE/PONY HACK** is open to horses/ponies 5 years old and under. They will be shown as a group on the flat, at the walk, trot and canter (both directions of the ring). They will be judged on movement, manners and way of going. Performance to count for 50% on the flat. Then each entry will jump 2 jumps, horses not to exceed 2'3" and ponies not to exceed 18". Performance over fences to count for 50%. The classes will be combined if less than 4 horses/ponies enter. Schooling will be available for the Young Hunter classes before each division (horses & ponies).
17. **YOUNG HUNTER HORSE/PONY UNDER SADDLE** class is open to horses/ponies 5 years old and under. They will be shown as a group at the walk, trot and canter (both directions of the ring). To be judged on performance, soundness, manners and way of going, 50%. Will then be stripped for conformation which counts for 50% and placed in the order of the judges preference head to tail. The classes will be combined if less than 3 horse/pony entered. Schooling will be available for the Young Hunter classes before each division (horse & pony).
18. **YOUNG WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY UNDER SADDLE** class is open to horses/ponies 5 years and under suitable to become hunters. They will be shown as a group at the walk, trot and canter, (both directions of the ring)not to jump. Will be judged on performance, soundness, movement, manners and way of going. The classes will be combined if less than 3 horse/pony entered.
19. **THE PAHBF will offer a PENNSYLVANIA BRED** Class with an entry fee of \$25.00. The section offered is: Yearling & Weanling Horse and Yearling & Weanling Pony. The class is open to all PA bred in their respective section. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded in each section.
20. **PRIZE MONEY DISTRIBUTION:** Futurity checks for the Champion Yearling & Weanling and for the Reserve Champion Yearling & Weanling will be mailed no later than 10 business days after the day of the show. Prize money recipients winning more than \$600 or more will receive a 1099 tax form.
21. **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:** A PA Bred horse/pony is one conceived or foaled in the state of Pennsylvania. Offspring whose sire stood in PA during the year of conception, will also be considered PA BRED.
